MAP Testing - May 6 - 10



MAP testing is a standardized test which is given three times a year and is used in OPS as well as many districts throughout the country. The results help us compare each child's progress to their peers at the same grade level. We use the testing to help us determine what academic areas your child needs extra help. This testing format is also great for students to experience test questions and formats that are different from their daily work.

The MAP program offers comparative data from fall, winter and spring and allows for goal setting which your child is involved in projecting.

Please make every effort to avoid **morning** appointments during this week and have your child here on time so they will not be missing these crucial testing periods.

Children's Scholarship Fund of Omaha

Children's Scholarship Fund (CSF) provides scholarships for students in grades Kindergarten through Eighth grade whose family qualifies financially (see income bracket below). CSF is available for many private and parochial schools in the Omaha metro area, including

Phoenix Academy. If a family qualifies for CSF it may be used at any of the participating private schools and can be transferred between schools. New applicants must fill out an application through CSF and then will be entered into a lottery. Renewal applicants should have received information by email. All applications are due by May 3rd, 2019 for the 2019-2020 school year.

We will also be offering a **CSF Help Session** here at Phoenix Academy on Tuesday, April 16th, 3:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. This is a great way to help parents who need to upload documents. Please call Mrs. Liebermann if you have questions or need more information.
